PART B : PROJECT CONTEXT

Project Summary:

Tibetan Homes Foundation takes care of more than 100 older persons since its inception in 1962. A total of 70 older people's lives in the two old age homes run by the institute. Evening life is sometimes difficult when we have no one to take care of us. Tibetan Homes Foundation tries to provide smooth evening life to our elders who live with us at two old age homes – one at Mussoorie and other at Rajpur located at Rajpur branch. Several projects for the elders were implemented every year to make them feel that they are cared at the evening of their life. The most important project has always been the provision of better living arrangements at their home including meals, medication, clothes and care.

Why the project need?

Our elders living in the old home Mussoorie gathered for prayer and often in the evening after their dinner in the prayer gathering cum dinning room. This used to be the best time for our elders and the best space in the home to share their early life stories, experiences and journeys. The dining cum prayer hall is devoid of comfort zone for our elders despite few benches and a small television. Majority of our elders were patient of high blood pressure, joint pains, limited mobility and backache. The existing benches and furniture in the hall needs to replace trying to provide a comfort area to all the elders living in the home.

Beneficiaries

The direct beneficiaries were the 24 older persons living with us here at GAT - Old Age Home, Mussoorie. The age group of 60 to 98 years of elder will benefit from the project. The provision of comfort furniture in the Dining cum Prayer will be a gift to all the elders when they spend time with each other.

Justification

The provision of comfort, cushions, and a television and floor carpet in the Dining cum prayer room will be a gift for our elders to spend time with each other while they gathered during evening. Moreover, our elders love to spend most of their time in the dining hall where they can share their time together with each other.
