## PART B : PROJECT CONTEXT

### Introduction:

Tibetan Homes Foundation (THF) is a registered charitable institute dedicated to working for the care of orphan, semi-orphan and destitute Tibetan refugee children. More than five decades have gone by since its small beginning in November 1962 at Mussoorie by His Holiness Tenzin Gyatso the XIVth Dalai Lama. Tibetan Homes Foundation has been taking care of Tibetan refugee children in exile and senior citizens under its old age homes. The institute as a whole tries to work effectively with its mission to care for the Tibetan refugee children in exile under its care, to provide with the best possible means of good education so that these children grow up as self reliant and contributing members of community at large, to impart and inculcate the rich traditions, moral values and cultural heritage of Tibet to preserve and promote our Tibetan identity that faces great danger of being wiped out, to provide a good care needed for senior citizens who are left on their own at the evening of their life, and to render other social services in the form of "Outreach Community Program

### Project Summary:

Tibetan Homes Foundation, Mussoorie, Rajpur and Gohri Mafi take care of a total of 1750 children and 70 senior citizens with the overall care and development. School remains closed for two months in winter (January and February) as the temperature remains down during these two months. The location of Mussoorie being on an elevation of 2006 metres remains cold most of the time. Children's especially elderly people were provided with quilt and warm blankets. The provision of new warm quilt cover is necessary as the one used by children and elders were mostly worn out and not of hygienic clothe.

### Why the project need?

- ✓ To keep during winter
- ✓ The present ones were worn out
- ✓ The one in use at present needs to replace.
- ✓ Warm cover to elderly people is necessary as the location remains cold.
