PART B: PROJECT CONTEXT

Introduction: Tibetan Homes Foundation (THF) is a registered charitable institute dedicated to working for the care of orphan, semi-orphan and destitute Tibetan refugee children. More than five decades have gone by since its small beginning in November 1962 at Mussoorie by His Holiness Tenzin Gyatso the XIVth Dalai Lama. Tibetan Homes Foundation has been taking care of Tibetan refugee children in exile and senior citizens under its old age homes. The institute as a whole tries to work effectively with its mission to care for the Tibetan refugee children in exile under its care, to provide with the best possible means of good education so that these children grow up as self reliant and contributing members of community at large, to impart and inculcate the rich traditions, moral values and cultural heritage of Tibet to preserve and promote our Tibetan identity that faces great danger of being wiped out, to provide a good care needed for senior citizens who are left on their own at the evening of their life, and to render other social services in the form of “Outreach Community Program

Summary: Tibetan Homes Foundation Rajpur branch school is established in the year 1999 with classes till primary. The school was gradually upgraded and at present, the branch school is a higher secondary school affiliated under CBSE. The need for the playground becomes one of our priorities as it plays a vital role in the overall development of a child and is also one of the necessities under the CBSE norms. The old building adjacent to the school was demolished few years back with a plan to construct a school playground on the space available. The total anticipated budget is Rs. 29,55,255.00 and the project is still awaited for implementation due to lack of funds.

Needs / Problems: Tibetan Homes Foundation Rajpur branch school is established in the year 1999 with classes from Kindergarten to Grade – X. The school is affiliated to CBSE with the institute providing all the possible means of modern education to the Tibetan refugee and destitute children under its overall developmental care which becomes possible with the unwavering support from our sponsoring associations. The need for the playground cum extracurricular activity ground for the children at the branch school becomes one of our priority as every year, several activities for the children has to be carried as per the school affiliations norms and also for the annual activities of the school. The old building adjacent to the school which house around 100 senior citizens has been already demolished 7 years before and the space is made available for the construction of a playground. The plan project was unable to implement and was pending for a longtime due to lack of funds.

Goals / Objectives: The long awaited project will greatly benefit the strength of 410 Tibetan refugee children and staff living in the Tibetan Homes Foundation Rajpur branch school. The implementation of the project will not only benefit the school for the affiliation renewal but will also plays an essential role in the social, emotional, cognitive and physical well being of our children in the branch school right from the stage of early childhood till adolescence. The project implementation will also help to utilize the available space for which the demolished of the senior citizens home has been made few years back. Since the playground is one of the vital part of childhood that helps children develop physical strength, coordination and balance, the fund support towards this project is our priority.

Procedures / Scope of work: Implementation of project will commence as soon as the project will receive funds. THF Management committee headed by General Secretary and Assistant General Secretary will head the project with market analysis and project implementation.

Justification:

A total of 410 children under the overall development of Tibetan Homes Foundation, Rajpur will benefit from the project actualization.
