PART B: PROJECT CONTEXT

School Background:

Tibetan Homes Foundation Rajpur branch school was established in the year 1999 as primary school. The school was gradually upgraded and at present, the branch school is higher secondary school affiliated with CBSE. The school premise is surrounded by neighborhood residences. A streambed demarcates the school premises and the neighborhood at one end. On one end side soil erosion takes places during monsoon season along the school end stretched on the other side the streambed is becoming narrower due to the construction activities from across the neighbor's end. Therefore, a retaining wall and a boundary wall along the stretch are critically needed to prevent soil erosion and encroachment in the future.

Introduction

Tibetan Homes Foundation (THF) is a registered charitable institution dedicated to working for care of orphans, semi-orphans, destitute Tibetan refugee children and needed elders. THF was established in the vear 1962 as a home for orphans, semi-orphans and destitute Tibetan refugee children inspired by the far sighted vision of His Holiness the XIVth Dalai Lama. THF works ceaselessly towards providing Tibetan children under its fold a homely care and decent education along creating positive environment and facilities for sustaining the unique Tibetan identity. THF also takes care of its retired employees and maintains two homes for needy elders. THF also renders social service supports through its "Out reach community program".

Problem Statement:

Tibetan Homes Foundation Rajpur branch school with its inception in 1999 provides holistic upbringing to 580 children at present. The school is affiliated under Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) and is a higher secondary school. Physical development based sports and athletic activities becomes a vital part in the over round development of a child. The need for a sports ground is one of the prime concern based the physical, mental, intellectual and social wellbeing of a child. More importantly, the need for a sports ground is one of the important need criteria as mentioned under school board affiliation. The need being felt, senior citizens home located inside the school campus is relocated 8 years back making the space available. Unfortunately, the space is still under utilized due to the resource constrain. Tibetan Homes Foundation has to put off the project.

Justification:

The project was unable to implement for the last 12 years due to fund constraint. In year 2017, we were able to start with the retaining wall due to partial grant support from The Tibet Fund, USA. The project is only partially covered with the retaining wall constructed based it urgency with the threat from encroachment and child fall. The ground leveling and fencing will help us and our children to have a complete school infrastructure.
