**PART B: PROJECT CONTEXT**

**B.1. Introduction:**

Tibetan Homes Foundation (THF) is a registered charitable institute dedicated to working for the care of orphan, semi-orphan and destitute Tibetan refugee children. More than five decades have gone by since its small beginning in November 1962 at Mussoorie by His Holiness Tenzin Gyatso the XIVth Dalai Lama. Tibetan Homes Foundation has been taking care of Tibetan refugee children in exile and senior citizens under its old age homes. The institute as a whole tries to work effectively with its mission to care for the Tibetan refugee children in exile under its care, to provide with the best possible means of good education so that these children grow up as self reliant and contributing members of community at large, to impart and inculcate the rich traditions, moral values and cultural heritage of Tibet to preserve and promote our Tibetan identity that faces great danger of being wiped out, to provide a good care needed for senior citizens who are left on their own at the evening of their life, and to render other social services in the form of “Outreach Community Program.

**B.2. Problem statement :**

All our children living in different homes were provided with seasonal foods once in fortnight which is also cost effective. But, there is no proper storage in the homes and the foster parents have limited knowledge on the food preservation resulting in waste of vegetables and fruits.

**B.3. Objectives:**

The main objectives of the trainings is give a short term workshop to foster parents with the fermentation of left over vegetables and fruits which is not only a great way to store seasonal produce but also enhances the availability of vitamins and minerals.

**C.1. Project Outcomes :**

Children will have a pastoral care under the foster parents in their different homes leaving a positive impact on their overall development.



**C.2. Project Outputs:**

Six days of short term Pickling workshop will cover 109 – foster parents taking care of children of Tibetan Homes foundation in three schools.
