PART B : PROJECT CONTEXT

Introduction:

Tibetan Homes Foundation (THF) is a registered charitable institute dedicated to working for the care of orphan, semi-orphan and destitute Tibetan refugee children. More than five decades have gone by since its small beginning in November 1962 at Mussoorie by His Holiness Tenzin Gyatso the XIVth Dalai Lama. Tibetan Homes Foundation has been taking care of Tibetan refugee children in exile and senior citizens under its old age homes. The institute as a whole tries to work effectively with its mission to care for the Tibetan refugee children in exile under its care, to provide with the best possible means of good education so that these children grow up as self reliant and contributing members of community at large, to impart and inculcate the rich traditions, moral values and cultural heritage of Tibet to preserve and promote our Tibetan identity that faces great danger of being wiped out, to provide a good care needed for senior citizens who are left on their own at the evening of their life, and to render other social services in the form of "Outreach Community Program

Project Summary:

A set of two bed sheets, pillow covers and quilt covers were provided to all the children when they lives in different homes. The replacement or provision of new bedding sets were done after receiving request from the foster parents who looks after the children in these homes. The one used by different SOS homes of Tibetan Homes Foundation Rajpur were not replaced since 11 years back. A need to replace becomes very necessary as small kids from 6 to 11 years lives in SOS homes.
