II. BACKGROUND :

Tibetan Homes Foundation is the first Tibetan school established by His Holiness the XIVth Dalai Lama soon after escaping to exile with the support received from the then prime minister of India – Pt. Jawarharlal Nehru and the Indian government. Initially, In 1962, Tibetan Homes Foundation was established with “75 Children” who were taken under care in three different homes with three couples to take care of them after school. The hard work of the Mr. and Mrs. Taring (Late) based the foundation of THF under the blessing of His Holiness the Dalai Lama. Our gratitude to all the former staff whose contribution in building Tibetan Homes Foundation will always be remembered. The support from our friends all over the world have always motivated our charitable institute to take long journey of “55 years” with thousands of children who have passed out from our family and now leading a self reliant life as a contributing member of our community. At present, Tibetan Homes Foundation has three branches with a total of “2151 – Children” and “135 – Senior Citizens” under the overall development and care.

III. Summary

Tibetan Homes foundation being a boarding educational school has a couple in each children home. The couple serves as a foster parent to take care of children in their respective homes which is “40 to 45” in larger homes and “10 to 12” in smaller homes. Children were taught almost all the household chores under the supervision and guidance of foster parents while they live in their respective homes. This helps our children to become more self reliant and self dependent as they grow up. Pastoral care and cultural upbringing is one of the most important inclusions in our school. All the clothes were washed by the senior children in almost all homes with the younger children given socks and inner wears to wash by them so as to let them learn. Somehow, a provision of washing machine was felt important to wash the heavy clothes including bed sheets, bed covers, quilt covers, homes curtains and blankets. The provision of same will also reduce the usage of water while washing heavy clothes. This will also consume less time and children can utilize their time in other corners.
