PART B : PROJECT CONTEXT

Introduction:

Tibetan Homes Foundation (THF) is a registered charitable institute dedicated to working for the care of orphan, semi-orphan and destitute Tibetan refugee children. More than five decades have gone by since its small beginning in November 1962 at Mussoorie by His Holiness Tenzin Gyatso the XIVth Dalai Lama. Tibetan Homes Foundation has been taking care of Tibetan refugee children in exile and senior citizens under its old age homes. The institute as a whole tries to work effectively with its mission to care for the Tibetan refugee children in exile under its care, to provide with the best possible means of good education so that these children grow up as self reliant and contributing members of community at large, to impart and inculcate the rich traditions, moral values and cultural heritage of Tibet to preserve and promote our Tibetan identity that faces great danger of being wiped out, to provide a good care needed for senior citizens who are left on their own at the evening of their life, and to render other social services in the form of "Outreach Community Program

Project Summary:

Tibetan Homes Foundation Mussoorie has three sections – Montessorie section, Primary section and secondary section. The Montessori section has our small kids from age 3 to 6. The section is divided into three classes Nursery, Lower Kindergarten and Upper Kindergarten. A total of 68 small kids were given a joyful learning in the section before they join the main school. A visual learning becomes a part and parcel for our kids in this section. And this becomes possible with the provision of smart learning equipment to the section.

Objectives (why the Project)?

The project is to provide a Smart Television to the section so that learning can become more joyful.

Beneficiaries

The direct beneficiaries were the small kids taking at the initial stage of their learning in the montessorie section. A total of 68 kids developing in Nursery, Upper Kindergarten and Lower Kindergarten will benefit from the provision of smart television.
