II. BACKGROUND :

Tibetan Homes Foundation is the first Tibetan school established by His Holiness the XIVth Dalai Lama soon after escaping to exile with the support received from the then prime minister of India – Pt. Jawarharlal Nehru and the Indian government. Initially, In 1962, Tibetan Homes Foundation was established with “75 Children” who were taken under care in three different homes with three couples to take care of them after school. The hard work of the Mr. and Mrs. Taring (Late) based the foundation of THF under the blessing of His Holiness the Dalai Lama. Our gratitude to all the former staff whose contribution in building Tibetan Homes Foundation will always be remembered. The support from our friends all over the world have always motivated our charitable institute to take long journey of “55 years” with thousands of children who have passed out from our family and now leading a self reliant life as a contributing member of our community. At present, Tibetan Homes Foundation has three branches with a total of “2151 – Children” and “135 – Senior Citizens” under the overall development and care.

III. Summary

Tibetan Homes foundation being a boarding educational school has a couple in each children home. The couple serves as a foster parent to take care of children in their respective homes which is “40 to 45” in larger homes and “10 to 12” in smaller homes. Children’s joined for their mid day meal at home which is normally rice served with cereals or vegetables. Foster parents prepared the meal and try to keep the rice warm by wrapping the rice utensil in a used blanket or sack. It is in practice with a try to serve children with warm rice but somehow it is not successful most of the time as the location of school is on hills. The project is to provide Rice Cooker for all the children homes for hygienic, warm and relish meal to children.

IV. Objective

To provide all children homes with “Rice Cooker” for a hygienic, relish and keep-warm option facility for children when they joined their respective homes for mid day meal.
