Subject : Providing of No-objection certificate to Tibetan Homes School, Raipur, Dehradun for affiliation to Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi.

Respected Sir.

In regard to the above subject I have been ordered to inform you that in regard to the providing of No-objection certificate for affiliation of Tibetan Homes School, Raipur, Dehradun to C.B.S.E., New Delhi the government has no problems in providing the same under the following conditions :

1. The school's registered society will be renewed from time to time
2. The school's management committee will include an appointed member by the Education Director.
3. The school will have a minimum reservation of 10% for Scheduled tribe/ Scheduled caste children and the fees taken from them will not be higher than the allocated fees in the schools run by the Uttaranchal Government, Dehradun
4. The school will not request for any subsidy from the Central Government and if the school in the past has recognition from the C.B.S.E. and Basic Educational Centre for such than from the date of its affiliation to C.B.S.E. all subsidies will automatically stop.
5. The school will not pay lesser or extra pay to its teaching and non-teaching staff members than the Government assisted educational school staff members.
6. Staff members service conditions will be made and they will be provided with retiring benefits as per the other schools under the Uttaranchal Government.
7. From time to time orders given to the school will have to be carried out

8. The school records will have to be kept in the format prepared.
9. On the above conditions unless approved by the government no changes can be made.
10. It is also a condition that the institute clarifies the following :
 - a) Classrooms, Teachers, land and Building position.

The fulfillment of the above conditions are compulsory and at any time if it is found that the institute is not complying of the same or any carelessness occurs than the government will take back the No-Objection certificate.
